



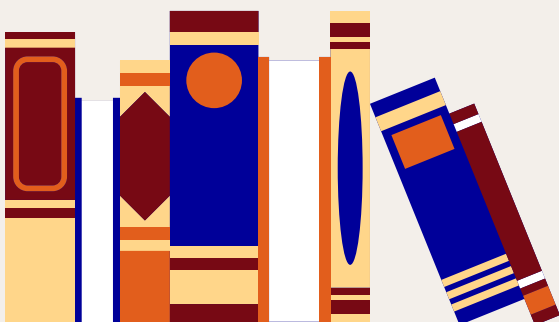

New Books

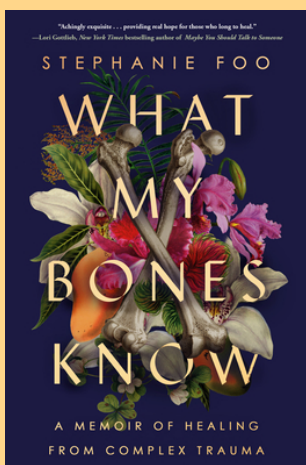
Here are a few of the new titles we've added recently.
